Used Item Donation Drop-Off Information

All used item donations for the Labor Day Auction may be dropped off at:

From all points using Route 30 (Monday – Friday before 10pm)

- Take Route 30 East or West to New Holland Avenue/Lancaster exit.
- Go through the two traffic lights that are the main entrances
- There is a blue sign after the second traffic light that is the entrance.
- Make a left in the Burle Business Park WEST entrance (there is a Recycle Station there as a landmark and if you go under the rail road bridge you went too far)
- Go up the driveway to the first building on the left

From Lancaster City (Monday – Friday before 10pm)

- Follow Route 23 towards Leola/New Holland
- Go past Kaye Ames and under the railroad bridge
- After the railroad bridge you will see a blue sign that says WEST Entrance (if you hit the
- traffic light at the main entrance you went too far)
- Make a right at the Burle Business Park West Entrance and up the drive way to the first building on the left

IMPORTANT NOTE: There's been a change to the accessibility to our warehouse on the weekends. The West Gate is now closed and locked at 11:00PM on Fridays and not opened again until 10:30PM on Sunday. Access is still possible through the Main Gate of the business park. Simply ask for directions to Building #16.

What to do once there

- Pull your vehicle up to the loading dock with your items.
- Walk up the stairs to the small metal door marked Phoenix Courier. Once inside, follow the hall to the right.
- Manually open the garage doors by pulling on the attached ropes.
- Unload the items onto pallets just inside the garage door. If there are no pallets or your item does not fit on the pallets, unload them on the concrete floor inside the garage door.
- Someone will then move the items to the official storage area at a later time.

Other Important Information

- The employees in the building will not know about the auction storage because they are not full time employees of Phoenix Courier.
- If you need to ask directions you should ask for Phoenix Courier NOT Hospice storage area.
